A. Colouring Competition

(Std. I to X)

Colouring sheets are enclosed. Students may use any colours of their choice.

B. Sketching Competition

(Std. I to X)

Topics:

1. Human Sketch
2. Landscape
3. Animal
4. Celebrity
5. Motivational Sketch

The choice of pen, pencil, and colours for shading is completely up to the students.

C. Handwriting Competition

(Nursery to Std. X)

The poem or paragraph for handwriting practice is enclosed.

D. Cartoon Making Competition

(Std. I to X)

Students are free to choose and draw any cartoon character.

E. Collage Competition

(Nursery to Std. X)

Pictures for the collage are enclosed. Students may use magazine cut-outs, craft paper, or any other creative materials.

F. Mask Making Competition

(Std. I to X)

Topics:

Students must write their name and grade on the mask. The mask should be made in A4 size only.
